

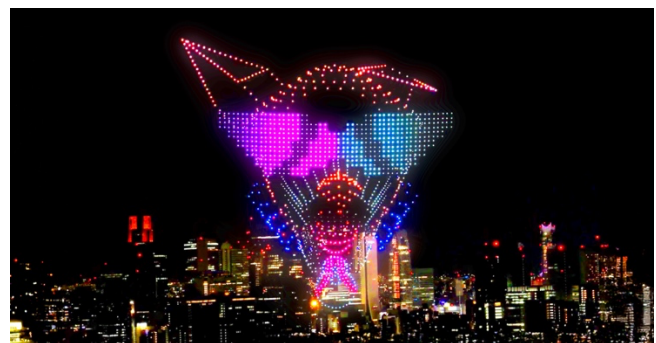
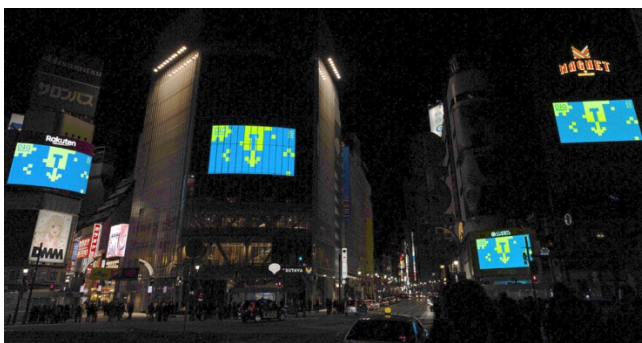

DIG SHIBUYA 2026 Announces Second Program Lineup

- Night-Time Drone Shows, Interactive Light & Sound Installations, and Urban Experiences Engaging All Five Senses

Shibuya, Tokyo — 22nd January 2026

The SHIBUYA CREATIVE TECH COMMITTEE, in collaboration with Shibuya City, is pleased to announce the 2nd wave of programs for **DIG SHIBUYA 2026**, a city-wide art and technology festival taking place from 13–15 February 2026 across the Shibuya area.



Following the initial program highlights, this second announcement introduces six additional projects that explore light, sound, the body, dialogue, and touch, expanding DIG SHIBUYA's vision of transforming the city into a platform for sensory and technological experimentation.

These newly announced programmes place particular emphasis on night-time urban experiences and participatory works, inviting audiences to engage with Shibuya through updated modes of perception and interaction.

Highlights:

- Shibuya Crossing Night Art: A midnight digital art programme at the Scramble Crossing**
DIG SHIBUYA's signature night-time programme returns, **synchronising four large screens** surrounding Shibuya Scramble Crossing for a one-hour digital art presentation. Late at night, when the city's rhythm shifts, the crossing becomes an open-air gallery—offering an unexpected encounter with moving images in one of Tokyo's most iconic locations.

2. Hello! Duetti: An interactive light and sound installation inviting spontaneous collaboration

Created by Canadian art and design studio Daily tous les jours, Hello! Duetti consists of benches and bollards that respond to subtle bodily movements. By simply sitting, swaying, or stepping, participants generate sounds that combine into spontaneous compositions—often with complete strangers.

This playful installation transforms everyday gestures into shared musical experiences, proposing new forms of dialogue and connection within the urban environment.

- **Dates:** 23 January – 27 February 2026
- **Location:** Pedestrian deck crossing Route 246 (between Shibuya Scramble Square and Shibuya Stream)

3. DIG SHIBUYA 2026 / Digital Garage DRONE SHOW “Earthshot”

Due to the success of past editions, DIG SHIBUYA presents a large-scale drone show that transforms the night sky above Shibuya into a canvas of light. Synchronised drones draw dynamic forms overhead, creating a fleeting yet memorable urban spectacle that merges technology, choreography, and live performance.

- **Date & Time:** 14 February 2026, after sunset (approx. 15–20 minutes, one show)
- **Location:** Above Yoyogi Park
- *Please note: The programme may be cancelled or adjusted depending on weather conditions.*

4. SCREENS CONTEXTUALIZED - Projecting Shibuya After Dark [Projection Mapping]

As part of the official SCREENS CONTEXTUALIZED programme, projection mapping works will be presented on the exterior of Shibuya PARCO, reimagining the building façade through light and moving images. By treating projection not merely as visual content but as a spatial and bodily phenomenon, the programme reshapes familiar landmarks into sites of nocturnal discovery.
